Think of someone in your life who has taught or mentored you in a meaningful way. What did that look like? How did their guidance shape your life?

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1. **Guidance Through the Spirit**: In John 16:12-14, Jesus tells His disciples that the Holy Spirit will guide them into all truth. How does this passage shape your understanding of the Holy Spirit's role in your life?
- 2. Scripture as God's Voice: Pastor Keith emphasized that "the Bible isn't just a book to be learned; it's God's voice to be heard." How does viewing Scripture as the voice of God affect the way you engage with it?
- 3. Learning the Voice of God: John 10:1-5 highlights that Jesus' followers recognize His voice. How can you practically grow in recognizing God's voice through the Holy Spirit?
- 4. **Jesus' Model of Listening**: John 5:19-20 shows that Jesus only did what He saw the Father doing. How can you adopt a similar posture of listening and dependence on God in your daily life?
- 5. **Discerning Truth in a Spiritual World**: With an increase in spiritual awareness in today's culture, 2 Corinthians 11:14 and Matthew 24:24 warn us about deception. How can staying rooted in Scripture help you discern truth from falsehood in a world of mixed messages?
- 6. **Partnership with the Holy Spirit Through Scripture**: Hebrews 4:12 describes the Word of God as "living and active." How can you deepen your partnership with the Holy Spirit through regular engagement with Scripture?
- 7. **Community and Spiritual Growth**: Pastor Keith talked about the importance of being around others who love the Word and engaging in groups for spiritual growth. How can fellowship with other believers enhance your relationship with the Holy Spirit?
