Big Idea

1. Pastor Keith said eternity is written into the human heart. Where do you see that in everyday life, even outside the church?
2. In the story of the rich man and Lazarus, both men die but their stories are not over. What stands out to you most about that contrast?
3. Jesus tells this story to religious leaders who were comfortable and secure. Why do you think He wanted them to “wake up”?
4. Paul says our outer self is wasting away, but our inner self is being renewed. What are some simple reminders in your own life that this body is not permanent?
5. Pastor Keith said teaching about judgment is meant to awaken us, not scare us. How does that change the way you hear passages about standing before Christ?
6. If every person you meet this week is an eternal being, how might that shape the way you treat your spouse, your kids, your coworkers, or even strangers?
7. The closing question was, “How much is eternity shaping you?” What is currently driving your decisions most, comfort and preference, or something bigger and lasting?
