Icebreaker

When you think of the word “home,” what comes to mind first? A place, a feeling, certain people? Why?

Big Idea

We were made for a greater home. This life is not the end, and what God has prepared for us is far beyond what we can imagine.

Discussion Questions

1. Jesus tells His disciples not to let their hearts be troubled because He is preparing a place for them. What does that reveal about how personal and intentional heaven is?
2. Pastor Keith said we are not home yet. In what areas of your life do you feel that tension most clearly?
3. The message pushed back on pop-culture ideas of heaven. What images or assumptions have shaped your thinking about heaven over the years?
4. We heard that we cannot crave what we know nothing about. How often do you actually think about heaven? What keeps you from setting your mind on it more regularly?
5. The promise of a resurrected, imperishable body stands in contrast to our current physical limitations. How does that give perspective to aging, sickness, or weakness?
6. Pastor Keith described heaven as unending discovery of Jesus, with limitless joy. How does that picture reshape the idea that heaven might be boring?
7. Jesus calls us to store up treasure in heaven. What would it look like this week to live with eternity in view instead of just chasing comfort here?
