Icebreaker

Think about one of the best moments you've ever experienced. What made it so meaningful or memorable?

Big Idea

The best moments we experience in this life are only a foretaste of what is coming. God gives us glimpses of joy now to anchor our hope in the life to come.

Discussion Questions

1. Pastor Keith shared that the best experiences we have in this life are only a small taste of what God has prepared for us. What moments in your life have felt like a glimpse of that deeper joy?
2. Pastor Keith warned that it is easy to anchor our hope in what is happening right now in the world. What kinds of things tend to pull your hope and attention toward the present instead of eternity?
3. Revelation describes a future where God wipes away every tear and makes all things new. How does that promise change the way you view the struggles you are facing right now?
4. Pastor Keith talked about how heaven means a “new you,” including a restored body. How might that truth encourage someone who is struggling with sickness, aging, or physical limitations?
5. Pastor Keith described heaven as a place where broken divisions and relationships are restored. How does that promise give hope in the middle of the relational pain people experience in this life?
6. Pastor Keith explained that believers will reign with Christ and be given meaningful responsibility. How does that change the way you think about your current work, school, or daily responsibilities?
7. Pastor Keith encouraged us not to waste our present opportunities because they are preparing us for eternity. What is one area of your life where you could begin living more intentionally with that long-term perspective?

Closing Reflection

Pastor Keith reminded us that God is making all things new and that our future with Him is secure. What anxiety or burden do you need to release to God this week as you trust in the future He has promised?
